


Introduction

Hull CVS is a charity that supports the development of a strong and effective voluntary and community sector locally.

CVS provides a range of support services for groups covering information, advice, training, grants, news and networking, as well as promoting and supporting volunteering in the city.

Key Points

Hull has a strong voluntary and community sector carrying out a range of functions in the City, frequently working with the most marginalised groups and communities.

Organisations and groups within the sector can often respond quickly to needs identified by communities, and often use innovative and person centred approaches to service delivery.

Working in partnership, the sector can help statutory partners to design and deliver improved services to local people. Commissioning services from the sector can help statutory partners meet their own outcomes and targets.

Hull CVS Database

As of 1st November 2009, 372 Voluntary and Community Groups working in Hull are on the Hull CVS database.

- 253 organisations class themselves as voluntary sector organisations and 157 have classed themselves as community groups (some groups have classed themselves as both a voluntary and community group).
- 167 are registered charities.
- 116 are local branches of national/regional voluntary organisations.

Generally speaking, voluntary sector organisations have paid staff, formal structures, provide specialist services and work across Hull, whereas community groups are volunteer-led, provide self-help and operate at a more local scale. Some community groups develop into larger voluntary organisations but many want to stay small.

Using our activities and interests, and ward information we are able to target our e-news bulletins to specific people and groups.

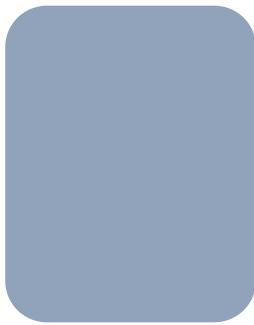
Website
